

LISA NAVES DANCE COMPANY FALL REGISTRATION PROCEDURE!

Registration Instructions

- ☐ Look over the classes listed. Cross off any classes the dancer is dropping. Write in any new classes requested. Write any comments/requests on the bottom or on the back of the form.
- ☐ Sign the bottom and return to Melva as soon as possible. Melva can then work out the cost for the year.
- ☐ Hand in full payment for the year in cash or post-dated cheques (first cheque dated Sept. 1) by **Monday, June 14**. The \$50.00 registration fee per student must also be submitted (goes towards recital costume).
- ☐ Just ask Melva for another registration form if a sibling of a current student is joining.

Questions and Answers

1. Why is there no day, time, and teacher listed?

The schedule for next year cannot be set in stone at this time. Most class times and days will stay the same. Similar to last year, all families will be called in the summer with their confirmed timetable.

2. Why is there no cost listed?

Until we know whether your child is adding or dropping classes, we cannot determine tuition. As mentioned above, Melva will work out the cost for you once the form is submitted.

3. What if payment and the registration form are not handed back in by **Monday, June 14**?

Then, unfortunately, we will assume that you are not returning to LNDC in the fall and the dancer will forfeit his/her spot in those classes.

4. What if we change our minds in the summer and decide to drop more classes or take a break from dance altogether?

All tuition will be refunded except the \$50.00 registration fee.

5. I have a friend who wants to bring her child to LNDC. How does she register?

New clients can register any night during the last two weeks of classes (**June 7-21**)

We will also be having registration on **August 22 & 23**.

6. Why is ballet listed twice on my child's form?

Once a student begins Grade 2 ballet, two classes per week are necessary in order to complete the syllabus. The second class also serves as preparation for examining in that grade level if the dancer is interested and if Miss Jennifer or Miss Teresa feels he/she is ready.

Special Notes

- ☐ Any student who took Leaps and Bounds (beginner) this year automatically moves to Leaps and Bounds (advanced) which is for four year olds.
- ☐ Once a student becomes five, they have the option of taking Level One classes in jazz, tap, ballet, and/or acrobatics. These classes are all 45 minutes long. You will note that jazz and ballet have been

listed on your child's form. This is just a recommendation. You are free to choose tap and/or acrobatics in addition to, or in place of these classes.

- Any student taking Intermediate Foundations or Intermediate ballet also has the option of taking a half hour pointe class that will follow one of the ballet classes, making it an hour and a half class. This is only if Miss Jennifer and Miss Teresa feels the student is strong enough. Please note...students must attend at least two ballet classes a week to be eligible to take pointe.
